Additional information

- 1) We will ask you to contribute 50 zł (less than 15 €) towards the cost of the dinner on Saturday.
- 2) Try to arrive on time to the Museum of the Cinematography (Saturday, 15h00), even if it means getting there directly from the bus/train station. We will help you with getting to your hotel afterwards.
- 3) Getting to Łódź from Warsaw can at times be tricky. If you are not successful with the bus (Polski Ekspres, usually goes 20 minutes after every odd hour, and some other bus companies; cost under 40 zł, around 11 €) located in front of the airport building, on the third lane, on the left, you can also try a train (which requires going to Warszawa Centralna station by bus or taxi) or, if you travel in a small group, a taxi. The cost of taxi is usually around 400 zł (110 €).
- 4) Change at the airport only the amount you really need. The exchange rate there is especially bad. It is easy to exchange money in Łódź, even on Saturday or Sunday. The exchange offices are called 'Kantor'.
- 5) Do not hesitate to contact us if you have a problem, even a small one.
